

## **2010 DEMOLITION DERBY RULES & REGULATIONS**

### **DRIVER'S ENTRY:**

1. All drivers must be 18 years of age or have a notarized minor's release submitted with the proper application (subject to approval of track steward).
2. All drivers must wear approved helmets (2000 Snell or better), long pants and long sleeve shirts. A fire suit is recommended.
3. The use of any alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs prior to competing will not be tolerated. Violation of this rule will be grounds for disqualification, suspension and ejection from the facility.

### **DRIVER'S RULES:**

1. Driver must have car at the track before 7:00 PM. Cars arriving after that time will be subject to a \$25 late inspection fee.
2. No head-on collisions and NO DRIVER'S DOOR hits.
3. The use of radios, cell phones and walkie-talkies is prohibited (subject to disqualification).
4. You have 30 seconds to hit another competitor. No teamwork or playing possum, this will be grounds for disqualification (subject to the official in charge).
5. All persons signing the release sheet will be covered by competitors insurance as follows:
  - a. \$5,000 Death
  - b. \$5,000 Dismemberment
  - c. \$5,000 Medical
  - d. \$40.00 per week, up to 26 weeks, after 8<sup>th</sup> day, if unable to work at regular job. All injuries must be reported to ambulance crew at once. NO EXCEPTIONS!
6. Attention must be paid to flagmen and track officials at all times.

7. **Winning car will be inspected for violations. Official's decision is final.**
8. If your car does not pass inspection or you are unwilling to make changes to comply with inspections, there will be no refunds.
9. Proper I.D. must be shown when coming to the pay-off window.

### **CAR SPECIFICATIONS AND SAFETY RULES:**

1. The use of anti-freeze is strictly prohibited and is cause for disqualification. A twenty-five dollar fine will be charged if anti-freeze is found during inspection.
2. The 8 Cylinder Division is open to any 1978 or newer American made unibody hard top passenger car (no compacts). Compacts and foreign cars are allowed in the 4/6 Cylinder Demolition Derby. **End of Season Skid Plate Race Cars: Skid plate cars may be used in the demolition derby providing the same model car is available in the 4 cylinder cars. In other words, the 6 cylinder cars may be used in the demo providing that model is made in the 4 cylinder.**
3. **All cars must remain stock with the following exceptions only:**
  - a. The fuel tank may be relocated or replaced. If moved or replaced, it must be with either a boat tank or a fuel cell. There must be a firewall between the driver and the fuel tank. The fuel tank may not be located in the driver's compartment. If the fuel tank is relocated or replaced the stock fuel tank must be removed from the car. Limit of five (5) gallons of fuel.
  - b. The battery may be relocated and mounted to the floor and must be covered to prevent acid spill. Only one securely mounted battery per car.
  - c. The shifter may be relocated on the floor.
  - d. Exhaust stacks may be installed.
4. Car must be completely gutted with the exception of the driver's seat and all glass must be removed with the exception of the windshield. Windshield may be replaced with chain link fence. Broken glass in doors and/or tailgate must be removed before arriving at the track. Drivers using fence rather than a windshield must have a have full-face shield on your helmet.
5. Seat belts are required and must be in proper working order and must be used at all times.
6. The driver's door must be painted a bright contrasting color (different than the car) and must be padded.
7. All doors, hood and trunk (tailgate) **must** be chained shut. Hood and trunk maximum of 4 chains each, doors maximum of 2. No threaded rods allowed. Hood must have a 12-inch hole cut above the carburetor in case of fire. Hood and trunk must be able to be opened for inspection.
8. Only cars that came stock with an electric fuel pump may use an electric fuel pump. You must have a clearly marked toggle switch to cut off the fuel, mounted on the dashboard within reach of the driver and safety crew.
9. **NO WELDING WILL BE ALLOWED. NO STUFFING OF THE CHASSIS WILL BE ALLOWED.** No reinforcement of any kind or any trailer hitches will be allowed. Anyone caught reinforcing their car in any way will be disqualified.
10. Maximum bumper height will be 24 inches.
11. Officials have the final decision on all matters relating to the rules and regulations.

**Note: In the 6 Cylinder Demolition Derby the wheelbase must be a minimum of 100 inches with a maximum of 104 inches.**
